The Keystone Center (CO) \$873,508 proposes the following project goals: 1) Develop clear expectations and guidance around implementing evidence-based family-schoolcommunity-partnership (FSCP) practices and structures at the state, district, and building level; 2) Increase implementation of FSCP practices and structures at each of these levels by cultivating the mindsets and skills of leadership and staff; and 3) Equip families with the selfbelief, knowledge, and skills to fully realize their potential as academic partners and active collaborators in decision-making. Because education institutions and communities across Colorado have varying needs and capacities to prioritize this work, they propose to provide three tiers of evidence-based programming with increasing levels of support to reach their goals. Tier 1 will revolve around a public website with downloadable resources, webinars, and learning opportunities for educators and families. Tier 2 will be structured around virtual learning communities for cohorts of educators, leaders, and families to deepen their knowledge and skills for FSCP over a period of several months. Tier 3 supports will be delivered in-person over multiple years and will focus on individualized, multi-session training and coaching for state/district leaders as well as educators and families on cultivating FSCP mindsets and skill development.
